Gilpin County Primary Election, June 26, 2018

ALL MAIL BALLOT ELECTION

Gilpin County Clerk and Recorder, Colleen Stewart, will be conducting a Mail Ballot Primary Election on June 26, 2018. The Clerk will begin mailing ballots on June 4, 2018. Ballots must be returned on or before Election Day by mail to the Gilpin County Clerk and Recorder, Colleen Stewart, P.O. Box 429, Central City, CO 80427 or dropped off at the following 24 hour drop off locations:

OLD COURTHOUSE, CENTRAL CITY, 203 Eureka St., Central City

GILPIN COUNTY COMMUNITY CENTER, 250 Norton Dr., Black Hawk.

GILPIN COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS SHOP, 135 Tolland Rd., Rollinsville.

This is a **Primary Election**. Affiliation Rules are:

- Voters affiliated with the **Democratic Party** will receive a Democratic Party ballot in the mail.
- Voters affiliated with the **Republican Party** will receive a Republican Party ballot in the mail.
- **Unaffiliated voters** will now be able to vote in the Primary! Unaffiliated voters will receive a ballot packet in the mail. The packet will include both the Democratic and Republican ballots. **VOTE ONLY ONE PARTY'S BALLOT** and return to the Clerk via mail or drop box. **IF BOTH PARTY BALLOTS ARE MARKED AND RETURNED, NEITHER BALLOT WILL COUNT.**

A new voter can register to vote at govotecolorado.com. A voter can make changes to their registration online until June 18, 2018. From June 18—June 26, 2018, a voter must appear at the VOTER SERVICE AND POLLING CENTER for these services.

ELECTION DAY, TUESDAY, June 26, 2018, 7:00 A.M. – 7:00 P.M.

FUNCTIONS OF THE VOTER SERVICE AND POLLING CENTER:

- A voter can surrender their mail ballot and vote in person either electronically or by paper.
- A new voter can register to vote and may vote the same day. (Must live in Colorado at least 22 days before the election).
- Drop-off location for Mail Ballots
- Update your name or address on the voter roles
