- **Plastic** -- Only recycle plastic bottles and tubs labelled #1 through #7. Remove the caps. ABSOLUTELY NO SYRINGES OR MEDICAL PLASTIC. PS (Styrofoam) block packaging is OK, however we cannot accept styrofoam cups, plates, or packing peanuts.
- **Steel** – Soup and food cans are OK. Please make sure any aerosol cans are totally empty including containers for shaving cream and hairspray. Labels are okay.
- **Chipboard or Paperboard** – This type of material includes; Cereal boxes, Soda carrier boxes, Tissue holders (Do not include tissues), Other food boxes such as popcorn or microwave food boxes (not the cooking sleeves), Paper egg cartons are okay, Paper towel and toilet paper tubes, flattened brown paper bags.
- **Office Paper and mail** – All types of office paper are accepted. If you can tear it, we can take it. All colors are fine as well. Don't worry about paperclips, staples, tape, stamps and sticky notes. These are all okay in the mix. NO TYVEK (polyethylene fiber) plastic, over-night mailing folders. Please discard plastic bags around magazines, catalogs and phone books. Remove items like CDs and magnets.
- **Glass bottles and jars:** We can recycle glass bottles and jars only. No Pyrex, cooking glass or window glass. Rinse and remove lids from food containers.
- **Corrugated Boxes:** See next page for recycling information.

# Other items recycled at Gilpin County Transfer Station

**Corrugated Boxes:** Please break down empty corrugated boxes and place them in the slot in the wall just north of the mixed recyclables bin. Small corrugated boxes, under 12” across can be emptied, flattened and included with bottles, cans and papers in the mixed recyclables roll-off container. Thanks! No charge.

**Scrap Metal:** Place ferrous and non-ferrous metals in our mixed metal bin for recycling. Metal fences and posts, bicycles (no tires), plumbing scraps, other mixed metals, washers, dryers & hot water heaters can be recycled but fees may apply. No refrigerators, freezers, or items that contained Freon. Grills are OK with fuel cylinders removed – cylinders must be de-valved and connections removed. No charge.

- Prices are for tires removed from the rim. A \$5.00 surcharge applies to tires on rims.
- We are unable to accept equipment tires, including skid steers, backhoes, loaders, etc.

**Motor oil and Anti-freeze** \$1.00 per gallon

- 2.5 gallon containers or smaller
- Liquids CANNOT be mixed together
- Must be free of contaminants from gasoline, diesel, brake fluid, water or any other substance.

## **Electronics Recycling:**

Waste electronics and computers cannot be disposed of in solid waste landfills in Colorado! Gilpin County Transfer Station offers the following options for electronics recycling.

• TV’s, computer monitors, and screens	\$1.50 per diagonal inch
• Desktop printers, PC’s, laptops, servers	\$8.00 each
• Stereos, DVD and CD players, VCR’s, Faxes, Radios, Scanners, Routers	\$5.00 each
• Small electronics, cell phones, hard drives, Keyboard, mouse,	\$1.00 each

The following items are exempt from the electronics recycling requirements. Many are accepted in the scrap metal recycling bin, or with regular solid waste:

- Washers, dryers, speakers, exercise equipment, humidifiers, air purifiers, hot water heaters. Cell phones with less than a 4” screen.
- Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, can only be recycled with proof of Certified Freon Removal. See Gilpin County Flyer Refrigerator disposal flier for more information.
